POLICY STATEMENT

We strive to ensure that all the activities (both academic & administrative) follow safe practices to ensure the health and well-being of all students, faculty and staff members. Materials Engineering Department is committed to the highest standard of health and safety and will ensure the following:

- All students, faculty and staff members are inducted to our Health & Safety procedures.
- Any identified unsafe act is immediately stopped.
- Any identified hazard is immediately dealt with, recorded and either made safe or quarantined to prevent any mishap.
- All accidents must be recorded.
- Conduct regular safety inspections of equipment, including fixings and fixing points.
- Ensure that there are adequate first aid facilities.
- Ensure that there are appropriate emergency procedures in place and that everyone is aware of what to do in an emergency (i.e. fire or power outage etc.)
- Ensure that adequate firefighting equipment is available and is regularly inspected and serviced.
- Encourage open communication and a ‘just culture’ attitude towards “Health & Safety”.
- Conduct regular reviews of the Health & Safety policies and procedures.
- Keep Health & Safety as the first agenda item at all committee meeting.
